

## GPTLA 3-15-26 Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 8 pm via phone.

Discussion was had about income tax. Gordon Howie stated GPTLA has never paid income tax, so it is believed that we did not have to pay them.

The secretary's report was given by Marlin Krump. There were no amendments, and they were approved.

Chris Nix presented the treasurer's report. It was the same as the last meeting. Chris has not written any checks. Only one check had to be reissued as it had not been cashed. We will reissue a check to Cheryl at Square One Photo as the first one was lost in the mail.

**GPTLA LOGO:** The new official GPTLA logo is the patriotic longhorn head submitted by Shawn Tobin. Voting passed on it 5-0. In the future we may use the brown logo submitted by Gordon Howie as transfers.

**PANELS FOR GPTLA SHOW:** Jackie Canfield is going to try and get extra panels for this year's show. Last year there were 85 animals at the show; this year expect a bigger crowd. Panel sponsorship entry closes two weeks before event. Shawn will be going down two days before the show to set up.

**GPTLA SHOW PROTEST COMMITTEE:** The TLBAA requires a protest committee at all shows. We will charge protestors \$250 maximum. They have two hours after the show comes to an end to file a protest. The protestors will lose their money if they are wrong about accusation. Gordon made a motion, seconded by Chris, with the motion passing 5-0. Lisa Saunders brought up the need for 3 people on the committee. We are asking for volunteers; if none within 45 days of show, Shawn will appoint them.

**GUN RAFFLE TICKETS:** One thousand tickets ordered, with a motion by Marlin Krump, second by Lisa Sanders they be ordered. Motion passed 5-0.

**SILENT AUCTION:** Marlin challenged everyone to be creative. Krumps already have four items for the auction. Lisa is also working on some things.

**FIELD DAYS:** It was brought up by Shawn Tobin to offer Field Days for members to host when they feel ready. Members will wait for invites from host ranches.

**BILLS TO BE PAID:** Reloader's Corner for the gun for the raffle; tickets for the gun raffle. Gordon Howie requested a reissue check to Cheryl from Square One as chest was lost in the mail and issued a check for \$350 to Mark Sanders.

FALL ROUND-UP AD: The GPTLA paid for the ad taken out by Gordon Howie and the Sanders'. Gordon stated they would reimburse the GPTLA for the ad.

With no other business, motion by Chris Nix to adjourn, with a second by Lisa Sanders.
